## **1. INTRODUCTION**

TalentBurst, Inc. and its affiliates ("TalentBurst", "we", "us", or "our") adopts this Privacy Notice at Collection for California Independent Contractors ("the "Privacy Notice") to comply with the California Consumer Privacy Act ("CCPA") and the California Privacy Rights Act ("CPRA"). Any terms defined in the CCPA or the CPRA have the same meaning when used in this Privacy Notice. ### 2. INFORMATION WE COLLECT

TalentBurst collects and uses your personal information, including what may be considered sensitive personal information, for contracting, health and safety, and business-related purposes and to comply with local, state, and federal legal obligations. TalentBurst obtains the categories of personal information listed below directly from you and the information you provide to us through the Website or the App. TalentBurst will not collect additional categories of personal information or use the personal information collected for materially different, unrelated, or incompatible purposes without first providing you with additional and/or updated notice.

Sensitive personal information is a subtype of personal information consisting of specific information categories. While we collect information that may be considered sensitive personal information under the CCPA, the CCPA does not treat this information as sensitive because we do not collect or use it to infer characteristics about a person.

TalentBurst does not sell the personal information we collect our job applicants, prospective employees, and employees or share it with third parties for cross-context behavioral advertising.
